# **EDUCATIONAL CONTENT**

### Description

The Master of Law of the Universities of Zurich and Lausanne comprises 90 ECTS credits for a duration of 5 semesters at most. At least one semester is spent with each of the partner Faculties. The ECTS credits are distributed as follows:

- 36 ECTS course credits at the Faculty of Law of the University of Zurich
- 36 ECTS course credits at the Faculty of Law, Criminal Justice and Public Administration of the University of Lausanne
- 18 ECTS course credits for the Master's thesis, completed at one and/or the other of the partner Faculties

#### Award of the degree

Once 90 ECTS credits have been obtained in accordance with the regulations, the degree of Master of Law of the Universities of Zurich and Lausanne is awarded jointly by the two universities.
